



LORÁNT VINCZE

*Washington, D.C. Visit by Elected Representatives
of the Hungarian Minority in Romania,
November 27 – December 1, 2023*

Loránt VINCZE is Member of the European Parliament since 2019, elected on the list of the Democratic Alliance of Hungarians in Romania (DAHR – Hungarian acronym: RMDSZ), a part of the European People’s Party Group.

He serves as Vice Chair of the Committee on Constitutional Affairs and co-Chair of the Intergroup on Traditional Minorities. He is also a member of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs, the Committee on Petitions and of the **Inter-parliamentary delegations with the United States, the United Kingdom and India.**

Since 2016, Vincze is also **President of the Federal Union of European Nationalities (FUEN)** the largest umbrella organization of European minorities. Established in 1949, the FUEN currently has 105 member organizations from 36 European states. The organization coordinated the successful **Minority SafePack European Citizen’s Initiative** gathering over 1 million signatures.

- Born 1977 in Tîrgu-Mureş (Marosvásárhely).
- Vincze studied journalism, and he holds an MA in public administration and e-government from Bucharest University.
- Between 1997 and 2009, he worked as radio journalist and manager at various Hungarian language media outlets in Romania.
